- 30% have committed to being more careful when it comes to sorting recyclables






Staying In:

- Aluminum **17%**
- Glass **13%**
- PET (plastic water bottles) 7%

Online Shopping:

The USPS reported package volume increased by 19% in 2020. Republic Services has seen as much as a **63% increase in residential cardboard** in some locations.





Compost Generation:

Organic waste increased by **20%**, creating more than over half a million tons of nutrient-rich compost.
